The chosen venue for our ceremony and gala dinner on Saturday the 10th November is the celebrated St Salvator's College with its attached 15th century Chapel in the picturesque historic coastal town of St Andrews, in the Kingdom of Fife, some 40 miles north of the capital city of Edinburgh. The hotel and meeting point is nearby in the impressive new Holiday Inn Hotel in Dundee, the "City of Discovery."
